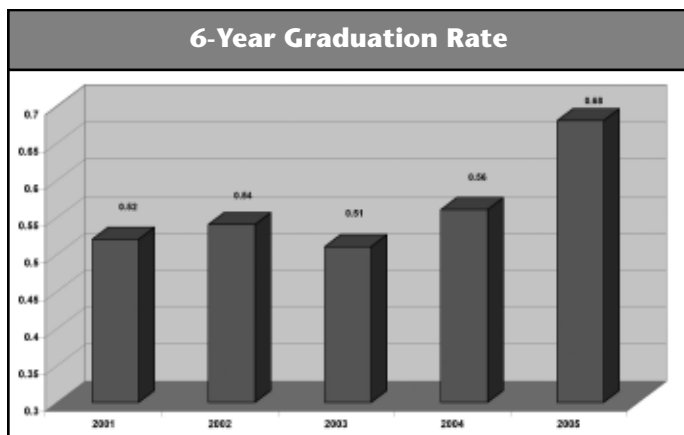

*A Word of Explanation:* In the fall of 1996, there were 515 first-time freshmen in the cohort. In the fall of 1997, 354 of the original cohort returned for a 69% retention rate. The graduation rate for this cohort shows that 279 students from the 1996 cohort graduated in 6 years for a 54% graduation rate.
