This checklist is only a guide to courses.

A schedule of classes is published annually. Careful planning is essential. A nursing faculty advisor is assigned to each student for assistance. Schedules must be approved in advance by a nursing advisor. 128 units required for PLNU graduation. Last 24 units must be in residence.

- ** Strongly recommended prior to Adult Health I, but may be taken concurrently.
- *** Responding to the Sacred: Transfer students with ≥ 57 units need take only 2 courses at PLNU (one course must be upper division = CHU 395 or THE 306)
- + Child Development may be accepted in lieu of Human Development, but student will be required to take 2 units in Adult Development during the nursing program.
- ++ Required for all Freshman students and transfer students with < 24 units. All others should take PSY 103.
- V If MTH 099 waived (per Math Department standards), COM 100 to be taken during Freshman year
- # Prerequisite for nursing courses
 - WRI 110 or WRI 115/116 – NSG 399 (Nursing Research)
 - MTH 203 – NSG 399 (Nursing Research)
 - PSY 321 – NSG 450 (Community Mental Health)
- Δ SOC 360 and one of the following: SOC 101, SOC 102, POL 101, POL 190, ECO 101, or ECO 102 are prerequisites to NSG 460
