RE: Scholarship Application Information

Education Associates (EDUCAP), the Alumni Education support organization, will be awarding scholarships again this year. These scholarships are for use during the 2007-2008 school year. Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis, which includes an application form being submitted and a personal interview. The names of the scholarships, the amount of each scholarship and the eligibility qualifications are listed on the next page.

Steps to apply for an **Education Associates (EDUCAP) Scholarship** include:

1. Submit an application to the PLNU Education Office of the campus that you attend no later than 5:00 p.m. on **FRIDAY, February 16, 2007**.
Completing this Application gives your permission for the office to obtain the verification needed from the Records Office.
The Application must contain your Written statement of career plans and professional goals, along with the signature of your Teacher Education or Graduate Education Advisor, when it is submitted.
2. Attend the interview:
In San Diego on **Saturday, February 24, 2007**, starting at **9:00 a.m.**
In Bakersfield on **Saturday, March 3, 2007**, starting at **10:00 a.m.**
In Arcadia on **Saturday, March 10, 2007**, for the Arcadia and Corona Regional Centers starting at **10:00 a.m.**
3. Applicants who turn in **COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS** will be notified of the time of your interview by the Education Office, when the forms are submitted.
4. All applicants will be notified of the results after **March 31, 2007**.
5. The winning finalists will be awarded their scholarship at the **May 12, 2007**, Awards Breakfast to be held on the San Diego Campus. Details will be in your letter.
6. This award is for the 2007-2008 school year and is paid after the student has been admitted to the Teacher Education Program, and after July 1, 2007. Any classes taken after graduation are considered as being taken in the 2007-2008 school year.

EDUCATION ASSOCIATES (EDUCAP) SCHOLARSHIPS

Eligibility for scholarships includes:

Student definitely plans to enter the educational field professionally as a teacher.

Student has not completed a Clear Credential

Classes that will be taken after commencement are counted as being taken the next school year. However, funds will not be deposited until after July 1, 2007.

EDUCAP Scholarship- up to \$500.00

Vern Pearson Founders' Scholarship - up to \$500.00

Hill Memorial Award - up to \$500.00

The following scholarships require the above qualifications with these additions/changes:

Moulton Education Scholarship - minimum \$750.00

Must be an undergraduate

Requires GPA of 3.0 or above

Must be an Elementary Education applicant

EDUCAP Special Education Scholarship - up to \$500.00

Student definitely plans to go into Special Education

Can hold a preliminary or full credential in "regular education"

Has not completed the Special Education Credential

Beryl and Hazel Dillman Early Childhood Education/Elementary School and/or Christian Educators Scholarship - minimum of \$500.00

Applicant plans to teach in Early Childhood Education/Elementary School and/or is planning to teach in a Christian School setting

Applicant can be a current teacher in a Christian School, who wishes to further their education, at the University level

Scholarship money for the above scholarships will not be awarded until the student has been admitted to the Teacher Education Program.

Hart-EDUCAP Scholarship - up to \$500.00

Anyone enrolled in an Education Program at any of the PLNU sites

William and Thelma Rhone Graduate Education Scholarship -up to \$500.00

Applicant must be taking their graduate work at the Arcadia Regional Center

Applicant must be working towards a graduate degree in the field of education

A completed application allows each student to be considered for one of the scholarships for which he/she qualifies.
