Has your son or daughter set up parent permissions for release of financial information and told us who should have online access to the bill?</p> <p>23rd: Last Day to enroll in the Tuition Refund Plan...the only way to get a full tuition refund at any time during the school year!</p>	<p>4th: Last day for 100% tuition refund for dropped classes, change a meal plan, or add fall semester classes</p> <p>9th: Late fees applied on the unpaid balance</p> <p>11th: Last Day for 75% tuition refund for dropped classes</p> <p>18th: Last Day to waive Health Insurance (or be charged the health fee) and last day for 50% tuition refund for dropped classes</p>	<p>Parent Weekend – 2nd and 3rd</p> <p>14th: Financial holds placed on students with unpaid Fall 09 balances (Students will not be able to register for Spring 10 classes until balances are paid in full.)</p> <p>17th: Last Day for 25% tuition refund for dropped classes</p>	<p>2nd: Priority Registration begins for Spring 2010</p> <p>6th: Last day to drop classes- No eligibility for tuition refunds</p> <p>Study Abroad? Student thinking about it for spring semester? Make sure they stop by SFS to see what aid may be available.</p>	<p>18th: Last Day of Classes for Fall 09</p> <p>Watch for the Spring 10 billing statement in the mail.</p> <p>Encourage your student to talk now with their department faculty about eligibility for department scholarships for next year. Most department awards are made in the spring semester for the following Academic Year.</p> <p>Don't pay for filing a FAFSA...it's free and online at www.fafsa.ed.gov</p>

<p>4th: Spring 10 payment due</p> <p>11th: 1st Day of Classes</p> <p>22nd: Last Day for 100% tuition refund for dropped classes, to change a meal plan, or to add classes</p> <p>29th: Last Day for 75% tuition refund for dropped classes</p> <p>1098 T tax forms will be available online by the end of January; begin now to gather 2009 tax and W-2 data to file the 10/11 FAFSA.</p>	<p>5th: Last Day to waive health insurance and last day for 50% tuition refund for dropped classes</p> <p>9th: Late fees applied on the unpaid balance</p> <p>File your FAFSA no later than March 2nd!</p>	<p>2nd: FAFSA Priority Deadline</p> <p>5th: Last Day for 25% tuition refund for dropped classes</p> <p>19th: Financial holds placed on students with unpaid Spring 10 balances (Students will not be able to register for Fall or Summer 2010 classes until balances are paid in full and may also have their ability to be assigned for housing in the Fall 2010 semester affected!)</p> <p>26th: Last day to drop SP 2010 classes- No tuition refund</p>	<p>16th: SFS Named Scholarship application due- ONE application allows them to apply for over 20 scholarships! <u>Do not let your student miss out!</u></p> <p>12th: Priority registration begins for Fall 2010</p> <p>Is your student planning to take classes or work on campus this summer? They must visit a SFS Advisor to complete paperwork.</p>	<p>14th: Last Day of Classes for Spring 10</p> <p>2010/2011 Award letters...are emailed starting in May. If your son or daughter has not received an award letter email by the last week of May, contact SFS!</p> <p>Parents: Did you know? Financial aid may be affected if your son or daughter falls below a 2.00 cumulative GPA or if they move off campus; always contact a Student Account advisor if you have questions.</p>
