**WASC ACCREDITATION UPDATE**

On October 4 - 6, 2006, a Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) team of evaluators will visit Point Loma Nazarene University. This team visit is part of a two-year assessment by WASC in the re-affirmation of PLNU's accreditation. The first cycle is called the Capacity and Preparatory Review, a basic audit of the university's report to WASC (to be filed in July of this academic year); the second, which will be filed in the fall of 2007, is the Educational Effectiveness Review aimed at assessment of claims to be made by the university in its presentation to WASC in the summer of 2007. The team will be headed by the president of Alverno College (WI), Dr. Mary J. Meehan.
