<sup>1</sup> Math proficiency courses are considered remedial and the units do not transfer to PLNU or count toward the units required for a bachelor's degree. Completion of this course waives the prerequisite for GE math and the nursing major.

<sup>2</sup> These courses are required for the BSN degree, but may be taken at PLNU concurrently with the first nursing courses.

<sup>3</sup> Child Development will be accepted in lieu of Human Development (FCS150), which is a required course for the Nursing major, but the student must complete a 2 unit course at PLNU in later developmental stages. The 2 unit course may be taken concurrently with first year nursing courses.

<sup>4</sup> These courses may be taken at PLNU concurrently with nursing courses.

<sup>5</sup> This course only applies toward the GE requirement for students who declared or began under the 2008-09 catalog or beyond.

<sup>6</sup> This requirement includes all first-time freshman who graduated from high school the semester before enrolling at PLNU, regardless of the number of transfer units earned in the summer or while concurrently enrolled in high school and junior college. PSY101 is also required for transfer students with fewer than 24 units. All other transfers need PSY103.
