



SAT or ACT Scores:

To send SAT scores to PLNU - <http://www.collegeboard.com/>

To send ACT scores to PLNU - <http://www.act.org/>

Students will not receive unit credit for SAT or ACT scores, but satisfactory scores will waive PLNU's remedial math requirement. Refer to the score guide listed below.

SAT

Score of **470** or **35th** percentile on the Math section waives **MTH099**

ACT

Score of **18** on Math section waives **MTH099**

If your score falls below 470 or 18, you may take the math placement exam at PLNU to try and waive MTH099. MTH 099 is a remedial (below 100 level) course. If you do not waive MTH 099, you must enroll in the actual course and those 3 units will NOT count toward the minimum of 128 units needed for graduation.

Other Placement Tests (SAT II, IB, CLEP):

At this time, PLNU does not offer SAT II tests except in the case of foreign languages. The SAT II will only waive the language requirement; students do not receive the units. The Office of Records evaluates and awards credit for IB transcripts on an individual basis after 12 units have been earned at PLNU. CLEP tests do not automatically transfer to PLNU. Students must petition for credit with the corresponding department chair after 12 units have been earned at PLNU. However, under no circumstances will Freshman Composition tests (with or without essay) be accepted for credit.

College Courses Taken in High School:

Students who take college courses in high school may be awarded credit if the course units appear on the transcript of an accredited college or university (not on high school transcript). Courses will undergo the same evaluation as any other transfer courses. Please contact your local college and request that your official transcripts be mailed to PLNU.
