A grade of "C" (2.0) or above is required in all sociology, prerequisite, and required courses. See your Catalog for prerequisites for progression through sociology.

A sociology course may not be used to complete two requirements. (Refer to the Sociology section of your catalog.) Sociology 103 or 201, 3 - 300 level sociology courses, 2 - 400 level sociology courses, and 1 course from each group below: Sociology 305, 360, 475, Sociology 103,201,316,320, Sociology 300,430,475, Sociology 350, 440.
