Enrolled at year two indicates if a first-time freshman student, who initially enrolled at census in fall (i.e. 2010) was also enrolled at census in the second fall (i.e. 2011).

IPEDS definition: A measure of the rate at which students persist in their educational program at an institution, expressed as a percentage. For four-year institutions, this is the percentage of first-time bachelors (or equivalent) degree-seeking undergraduates from the previous fall who are again enrolled in the current fall.
