<sup>1</sup> For Biology majors who receive a score of “5”, students must meet with their department chair before credit can be determined. The chair will then choose whether to award credit for BIO210 or BIO211 depending on the students’ strengths.

<sup>2</sup> A student cannot earn credit for both the Calculus AB and BC tests. Only the higher score of the two tests offering the most amount of credit will be considered. If a student has taken AP114 (Calculus AB) and AP115 (Calculus BC), and received a 2 or lower on the AP115 exam, use the AP114 table to calculate units and credit (using the AP114-AB subscore).

<sup>3</sup> A student cannot earn credit for both the Computer Science A and AB tests. Only the higher score of the two tests offering the most amount of credit will be considered. If a student has taken AP128 (Computer Science A) and AP129 (Computer Science AB), and received a 2 or lower on the AP129 exam, use the AP128 table to calculate units and credit.

<sup>4</sup> All first-time freshmen (including transfer students with fewer than 24 transferable units) are required to complete PSY101 at PLNU.

<sup>5</sup> Students who receive a score of “5” should meet with the Chemistry Department chair about possibly being awarded credit for CHE152 (with lab). The credit given for CHE101 does not include a lab.

This guide is subject to reevaluation and change each academic year. The credit awarded may differ depending on which year the student is admitted to PLNU. AP scores must be received by the PLNU Records Office in a sealed envelope from the College Board, not a student’s high school transcript.
