



General Education Transfer Agreement 2011 - 2012

All GE and major courses must be taken for a letter grade, not pass/fail

A combined maximum of 70 units may be transferred to PLNU from the following sources: community college, AP, CLEP, and IB. All courses transfer as lower division only.

Distance Learning not approved – all courses below must be completed in the classroom

The GE (General Education) courses listed in these agreements are created for students pursuing a Bachelor's degree at PLNU. Some majors may require a student to choose a specific GE course from this list. Please review your major requirements in the PLNU catalog to determine which GE courses may be required for your major.

¹ Calculus is only required for certain majors (see catalog for specific major requirements). All other majors have the option of taking MTH303, Problem Solving, at PLNU to complete the GE requirement.

² Current students or students who have previously attended PLNU must take a total of 8 units of science. Many transfer colleges only offer 3 unit non-lab sciences, so the lab is then required to complete the 8 unit requirement at PLNU. An exception is made for first-time transfer students who have already completed at least 7 units (with at least one lab) of a biological and physical science combined before transferring to PLNU.

³ Students must complete three semesters of this foreign language to equal the content covered in two semesters at PLNU.

⁴ This course only applies toward the GE requirement for students who declared or began under the 2008-09 catalog or beyond.

⁵ This requirement includes all first-time freshman who graduated from high school the semester before enrolling at PLNU, regardless of the number of transfer units earned in summer or while concurrently enrolled in high school and junior college. Transfer students with fewer than 24 units must also take PLNU's PSY101. All other transfers take PSY103.
